

# WHAT IS REAL ALE?

CAMRA defines real ale as:

Brewed from malted barley and hops — and without substitute materials such as hop oils and rice grits.

Stored in casks (either wood or metal) which allow it to continue fermenting between brewery and pub — not pasteurised and filtered at the brewery.

Served by any method which does not involve the use of extraneous carbon dioxide.

On pages 6 and 7 you will see in more detail the methods of storing and dispensing ale — both for the genuine article and for the stuff some of the brewers would have you believe is real beer.

# WHAT IS THE CAMPAIGN FOR REAL ALE?

The last person to be given a say in decisions by the breweries is nearly always you, the customer. Have you, for instance, found the handpumps ripped out of a pub, only to be replaced by the flashing lights of plastic boxes spewing out one gassy pint after another? How many times have you complained about the brewers, despite their claims that they are satisfying public demand? How many times have you been forced to drink something you didn't like, because that's what the brewers reckon you ought to be drinking?

The six major brewing combines in Britain are, in the main, the ones to blame for this state of affairs. Between them they produce nearly three-quarters of all our beer and own more than two-thirds of our pubs. Collectively, they have tried to do away with traditional draught beer and have been trying to replace it with filtered, pasteurised and pressurised products like keg beer.

It was clear some years ago that something needed to be done to give the beer drinker a say in what kind of ale would be made available to him. And that's where CAMRA — the Campaign for Real Ale — came in.

CAMRA is a democratic organisation run almost entirely on a voluntary basis. It seeks to protect the beer drinker by fighting for an improvement in the choice and quality of real draught beer and in the pubs where it is sold.

It has very little in the way of financial resources to match the big brewers' millions of pounds. But what it has lacked in terms of money it has more than made up for in the unstinting work given to the protection of our national drink by its membership. Now 30,000 strong and with over one hundred branches spread throughout the country CAMRA is making the breweries think twice before killing off traditional draught beer. The handpumps in dozens of pubs have been saved due to the activities of local branches. For the same reason other pubs are now selling handpumped beer for the first time in years.

But much more needs to be done — and CAMRA is doing it.

Members of Parliament who support the campaign are calling for all beer — both draught and bottled — to be clearly labelled so that the customer knows the strength and content of what he or she is buying.

## HOW YOU CAN HELP

If you want to help yourself and other drinkers to get a fairer deal from the brewers, you can start by sending the annual subscription of £2 to CAMRA headquarters at 34, Alma Road, St. Albans Herts, AL1 3BW. In return you will receive your membership card and your first copy of the campaign's monthly newspaper, What's Brewing — an indispensable read for all drinkers which gives the facts the brewers would like kept from you. All members are asked to make a point of going along to their nearest branch and helping the campaign at a local level. What's Brewing will tell you where and when your nearest branch meets.

# THE BREWS AND THE BREWERS

The quality of draught beer can only be judged by the drinker and the quality of a brew can and does vary between one pub and another. A pint can range from the sort worthy of a mention in a letter sent to the other side of the world to the, frankly, mediocre. It is for you, the drinker, to decide for yourself. 'Real Beer in London', therefore, does not pretend to be a guide to good beer, only real beer. Consequently no effort has been made to point out the virtues or otherwise of the various brews listed. With this reservation it can be fairly said that, equipped with 'Real Beer in London', the drinker can sample some of the best beer available in Britain.

#### BASS/CHARRINGTON

Supplies more draught beer to pubs in London than any other brewery. Three brews are sold — I.P.A. the most widely available, Bass (sometimes sold under the name Worthington 'E', an identical product), and Crown bitter.

#### **BRAKSPEAR**

Family owned concern based at Henley-on-Thames. Available at **The Hole in the Wall** (S.E.1.); **The Coronet Bar** (W1); **Tudor Close** (Richmond). New to London.

#### COURAGE

Currently engaged in re-introducing real ale into some thirty of its tied houses in London from the Horsleydown brewery S.E.1.

#### **FULLER, SMITH & TURNER**

One of only two independent brewers left in London (the other is Young & Co. of Wandsworth). Currently some twelve of Fuller's 116 tied houses are on draught. Their ESB is the strongest known draught bitter in the country.

#### GREENE KING

Only one or two outlets in London. The **Builder's Arms** in Barnet being one.

# IND COOPE (PART OF THE ALLIED BREWERIES GROUP)

Despite the huge number of pubs owned by Ind Coope only a few houses known to CAMRA sell draught beer.

#### MARSTON

Large but independent Burton brewer. One pub in London — Olde Cheshire Cheese (E.C.4.).

#### **McMULLEN**

Hertford family brewery. Try the Admiral Mann (N.7).

#### RUDDLE

Small but dynamic family concern operating from Rutland. Over the past year have established themselves in the Free Trade in London.

#### SAMUEL SMITH

About half a dozen pubs in London now sell Sam Smith's.

#### SHEPHERD NEAME

Independent Faversham brewery with a small number of

draught tied houses in London.

#### THEAKSTON

Only two outlets for this Masham (Yorkshire) brewery: The Coronet Bar (W1), and The Anglesea Arms (S.W.7.).

#### WHITBREAD

At the time of going to press it would appear that all brewing operations are about to cease at Whitbread's Chiswell Street brewery. Draught beer is currently available in about thirty of their tied houses. Whitbreads may supply their draught outlets from their brewery at Marlow.

#### **YOUNG**

Based in Wandsworth this is London's leading independent brewer. Virtually all tied houses are on draught. Firmly committed to producing and selling real ale.

## WHAT MAKES

Only about a third of Britain's 70,000 pubs sell natural draught beer, brewed and served in the finest tradition; the rest serve nothing but beers which have undergone unnatural processes, either in the brewery or after arriving at the pub.

Real ale is brewed from malted barley and hops, and fermented by adding yeast. It is served from casks made of wood or metal (or any other hygienic substance, for that matter), by any method which does not involve the artificial use of carbon dioxide gas.


Even if the beer is brewed from the best ingredients, it can be irretrievably ruined by two processes which have been finding increasing favour with brewers. The first of these — filtration — removes all the natural yeast and solids from the beer and makes it easier for the landlord to handle. But it also takes away the body that gives beer its character. The other process — pasteurisation — kills off any life left in the beer after filtration.

Beer which has not been killed off by filtration or pasteurisation is referred to as naturally conditioned beer, because it is allowed to continue to ferment (or condition) in a cask when it reaches the pub cellar. As it ferments, the beer gains in strength and flavour, as chemical reactions take place inside the cask. These reactions mainly convert the sugar in the brew into alcohol and give off carbon dioxide gas.

Traditionally, beer is stored in casks that have two holes: a bung hole and a spile hole that allows the carbon dioxide to escape as fermentation progresses. This involves careful supervision from the landlord, but if he does his job properly, the beer will leave the cask in peak condition.

Over the past 15 years or so, an increasing amount of beer has been stored in pressurised casks. These are the same containers as ordinary casks and the beer is usually brewed in the same way, without being filtered or pasteurised. But a cylinder of carbon dioxide is attached to the spile hole to prevent air getting to the beer. This method causes an excessive build-up of  $\mathrm{CO}_2$  and the beer becomes fizzy.

Pressurisation is taken to its extreme with kegs, which have only one opening, controlled by a valve. Kegs are highly pressurised with carbon dioxide and act in much the same way as an aerosol: the beer spurts out when the valve is

opened. The big brewers have been spending millions of pounds on promoting keg beers because they are to easy to store and serve — but they do not taste anything like beer in the accepted sense.


Kegs are also used by some breweries to store unpressurised filtered beers—generally referred to as bright beers because of their appearance in the glass. In theory, these beers would be a good second best to real ale, but they cannot be drawn out of the sealed containers without being pressurised to stop a vacuum forming.

Bright beer is also stored in large cellar tanks, especially in pubs which have a high turnover. The beer arrives from the brewery in large road tankers, like the ones used to carry petrol, and is piped into the cellar, usually under carbon dioxide pressure. Some tank beer is separated from the carbon dioxide pressure by a large plastic bag which deflates as the beer is drawn off, but because it is filtered — and sometimes pasteurised — it has less taste than cask beer.

Even the best beer can be ruined by the way it is served. The simplest way of getting beer into a glass is by gravity — putting the glass under the tap and letting the beer flow. Keeping the beer at the right temperature can be a problem if the casks are stored behind the bar — but this rarely presents difficulties to a skilful landlord. Beer served in this way usually looks flat — but the idea that beer needs a foaming head is a myth perpetuated by the big brewers, who add chemicals to their products to stop the foam dying away.

Beer engines, which are operated by the traditional handles on the bar, and electric pumps, which are operated by an electric motor, are both excellent ways of drawing beer from the cellar, so long as the cask is not pressurised.

Pressure pumps take advantage of the carbon dioxide which keeps air away from the beer in pressurised casks, kegs and tanks. When the barman operates the lever on the spout of the pump, more carbon dioxide is injected into the container, thereby pushing the beer out. Pumps which deliver beer in half-pint measures at the push of a button nearly always use carbon dioxide pressure to force the beer to a meter, but they should not be confused with unpressurised electric pumps which meter beer into half pints through glass cylinders or spheres, which contain a thin diaphragm. Unmetered electric pumps usually look exactly like pressure pumps, and can only be identified by asking the bar staff or by tasting the beer to see whether or not it is gassy.



#### THE EAST END

East London pubs show as much variety as does East London itself. From the fringe of Epping Forest (postal district E.4) to the industrial riverside (E.1., E.14., E.16.), or even from the salubrious Woodford (E.18.) to bibulous Bethnal Green (E.2.) the pubs change with the area. For variety is in some respects the spice of East London drinking. The main standard bearer of real beer in the area is Charrington — but take care, as by no means all Charrington pubs sell unpressurised beer. Youngs of Wandsworth, with their firm commitment to traditional draught beer, are also represented. Recently Courage have supplied one of their houses (The Black Lion, E.13.) with their draught Best Bitter and Director's Bitter. East London pubs are famous for their entertainment, especially at weekends. So be prepared for music at least, and don't be surprised to come across a drag show, comedian, stripper, or bare breasted gogo dancer during the course of an evening's real beer sampling. Generally, East London pubs are friendly and you will be made to feel welcome. Lastly, like no other area in the metropolis, a Saturday night's visit to the local (complete with seafood supper) is very much a family affair.

# THE CITY

The City of London, and its surrounding districts, is well stocked with pubs serving real beer. However, the area is unique in that early evening closing is widespread — often as early as 7.00pm. Not surprisingly, lunchtime is the obvious drinking time for City workers who range from stockbrokers to typists and the market porters of Leadenhall, Billingsgate and Smithfield. Pubs are very crowded with customers as much interested in the food as in the drink. The Old Watling (E.C.4.), for example, serves generous portions of French bread with slabs of meat or cheese. This pub is over three hundred years old and, happily, unspoilt. Ye Old Cheshire Cheese (E.C.4.), rebuilt in 1667 and once the haunt of Gibbon, Johnson and company, is the only outlet for Marston's beer in London. The Hoop and Grapes at Aldgate (E.C.3.), is distinguished by its leaning doorframe and also sells an acceptable pint of Charrington I.P.A. Although Whitbread are closing down their brewery in Chiswell Street it is believed that their Trophy bitter may continue to be supplied to some pubs from the old Wethered's brewery at Marlow. For those who would like to sample Whitbread's bitter in the City, from Chiswell Street or wherever, the Lamb Tavern (E.C.3.) is recommended. Of the other brews serving this area, Young's is available at the East India Arms (E.C.3.), Shepherd Neame at the Bishop's Finger (E.C.1.) and the Three Bucks (E.C.2.), and draught Ind Coope at the Station Buffet (E.C.2.).

# **NORTH LONDON:** HAMPSTEAD AND REGENTS PARK

Two areas of North London, Hampstead and Regents Park, are well served for a selection of real draught beer. Regents Park is sufficiently close to Camden Town for thirsty visitors to refresh themselves at The Engineer (N.W.1.), or the Landsdowne (N.W.1.), two good examples of the numerous Charrington houses in the area. Hampstead still retains its village atmosphere, despite its proximity to central London. (In happier times real beer was brewed by the Hampstead Brewery Co. whose buildings still stand). By Hampstead Heath Station (N. London Line) is the Magdala Tavern (N.W.4.) Charrington. Other fine pubs in the area include the Flask (N.W.3.) Young. and the Wells (N.W.3.) Whitbread.

Visitors to Sadlers Wells in Rosebery Avenue, need take only a short walk to The Empress of Russia (E.C.1.) for an excellent pint of Whitbread bitter.

For football supporters who are also real beer drinkers the nearest draught pub to Highbury is the Medina (N.7.), a Bass house.





# WANDSWORTH AND WIMBLEDON

South-west London is dominated by the Wandsworth based brewery of Young & Co. So many of Young's pubs are worth visiting that it would be almost unfair to single out individual

houses. But for the drinker who would like to spend an entire evening sampling Young's, the obvious place to start would be the **Brewery Tap** (S.W.18.). From there about a dozen of Young's tied houses are within walking distance. Another concentration of Young's houses can be found at Wimbledon. The **Hand in Hand** (S.W.19.) on Wimbledon Common, although a Young's tied house, also sells Ruddles ordinary bitter — a rarity for any part of London.

# THE WEST END

There are plenty of pubs to choose from in the West End although they tend to be noisy, crowded, and as cosmopolitan as the streets. Inevitably, due to the areas large floating population, a fair number lack the sort of character which only locally living 'regulars' can give a pub. But what the West End lacks in terms of geniune 'locals' it more than makes up for in choice of ale available.

For Cinema or Theatre goers in search of a pint before or after the show the Freemason's Arms (W.C.2.) Bass; and the Marquis of Anglesea (W.C.2.) Young, are worth a visit. Shoppers in Oxford Street might try the Coronet Bar (W.1.) where they will find a fine selection of handpumped beers including Sam Smith's, Ruddles 'County', and Theakston's 'Old Peculier'. At the Marble Arch end of Oxford Street is the Lamb and Flag (W.1.) selling Courage Director's Bitter. Further west the Brittania (W.8.) Young, is typical of pubs which serve good ale in Kensington and Chelsea (and which give the drinker a glimpse of the last vestiges of 'swinging London').

# WEST MIDDLESEX

The George and Dragon (Bass Charrington) in the quiet village of Downe and the Crown at Leaves Green (Shepherd Neame), noted for its mild ale and archery in the paddock, represent the rural aspect of the borough of Bromley.
